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The world becomes a bigger place and life gets more exciting as your baby becomes a toddler. A time of great adventure and discovery, the toddlers explore their physical development and extend their curiosities in a variety of areas. We provide a range of activities on different levels for our toddlers to explore, as they start to make their own choices about which areas to investigate.

From fun, social time such as circle time and singing, there are equally areas for quiet time, perhaps story time with a practitioner, and areas in which your child can be creative. Children at this age develop walking, balance and co-ordination skills, but also begin the important process of learning to form friendships and socialise with those of their own age. At mealtimes children are encouraged to feed themselves and by sitting with the practitioners at the table, start to enjoy the social aspect of mealtimes.

INVOLVE ME AND I LEARN

As your child moves into our 2-3-year-old's room, their exploration and co-operation skills develop more strongly, as they acquire discovery through play and enjoyment. As the practitioners introduce more structured activities, we ensure your child is constantly learning and being stimulated to experience new things. Children also learn to express themselves and their needs, and show sensitivity to their friends, with emphasis placed on positive behaviour.

While the children have the freedom to choose what to play with, they will also start to play games alongside each other, and will begin to show more independence in their own daily routine, for example, the children learn to serve their meals and dress themselves. This independence is gently encouraged and the practitioners will work closely alongside you and your child when you feel they are ready to start toilet training.

Children's communication and language development progresses during their time in this room. The children are often keen to share with us their experiences both from home and within nursery.

In this room, we prepare your child for a seamless transition to the great adventure that lies ahead: big school!

Pre-school is an important time in a child's life as they learn about the world and those around them. Our Pre-school staff provide a wide range of child-centred activities to create plenty of stimulating challenges. Our highly experienced team ensure that each child is happy, healthy, safe and motivated to learn and try new things, and we nurture the children to develop their skills, knowledge and attitudes. Within this room our highly skilled staff help children work towards the "Early Learning Goals" (the knowledge, skills and understanding that children should have at the end of the academic year in which they turn 5).

Key workers continue to assess and chart children's progress, and we involve parents every step of the way. Regular newsletters let parents know about upcoming topics and events within the room, such as celebrating festivals which are important here at home and across the world. These regular updates allow parents to support and encourage learning.
